

Public debate: **Should Art be Constrained by Landscape?**

Anthony Garratt's floating art installation on Llyn Llydaw, beneath Snowdon's summit, attracted media attention and controversy earlier this year.

In National Parks planning controls exist to conserve the 'natural beauty' of these protected landscapes, but artworks such as this are not always subject to such regulation.

The motion:

'This house considers that public art and arts related installations should not be subjected to any further development controls'

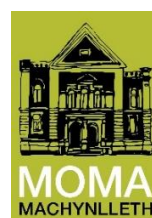
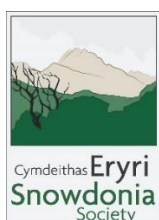
